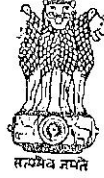

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by proviso of Article - 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the existing Recruitment Rules for the post Naiks (Armed) Men and Women the Governor is hereby pleased to make the following amended Rules regulating the method of Common Recruitment to the post of Naiks (Armed) Men & Women, Police Department.

1. **Short title and commencement :-**
 - (1) These rules may be called "Recruitment of Naik (Armed) Men & Women, Rules, 200
 - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. **Name of the Post :**

The name of the post shall be specified in Serial No.1 of the schedule annexed hereto.
3. **Number of Posts, Classification & Scale of Pay :**

Total number of posts, classification and scale of pay thereto shall be as specified in Serial No.2 to 4 of the Schedule.
4. **Age, Educational & Other Qualifications:**

Age limit, educational and other qualification required for the direct recruitment shall be specified under Serial No. 6 to 8 of the Schedule annexed hereto.
5. **Method of Recruitment, promotion :**

The method of Recruitment to the post shall be as specified under SI No.10 to 11 of the Schedule annexed hereto.

(ii) **Disqualification –**
No person –

 - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having spouse living; or
 - (b) who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts.

Provided that the State Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. Power to relax :- Where the State Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Tripura Public Service Commission, relax of the provisions of this Rule with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. Saving :- Nothing these Rules shall affect reservations, relaxation in limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Schedule Castes, the Schedule Tribes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the State Government/ Government of India from time to time in this regard. The post of Naiks (Armed) Men and Women shall be governed by the PRB 1943 as adopted by the Government of Tripura.

1.	Name of Post ::	Naik (Man and Woman) of Armed Branch.
2.	No. of Post ::	230 (218 Men & 12 Women) or as sanctioned from time to time.
3.	Classification ::	Group-C Non-Gazetted / Non-Ministerial
4.	Scale of Pay ::	Rs.3200-90-4280-100-5480-110-6030/- (Special pay Rs.120/- PM) as may revised by Government from time to time.
5.	Whether selection or non-selection ::	Selection
6.	Age limit for direct recruitment ::	Not applicable
7.	Educational and other qualifications required for the direct recruit will apply in case of promotion ::	Not applicable
8.	Whether age and qualification prescribed for the direct recruitment will apply in case of promotes ::	Not applicable
9.	Period of probation ::	2 Years
10.	Method of recruitment whether by direct recruit or by promotion or transfer and percentage of the vacancies to be filled up by various methods ::	100% by promotion
11.	In case of recruitment by promotion/transfer grades from which promotion /transfer is to be made ::	From amongst Constable (Man) Armed /Un-Armed, Constable (Women) Armed/Un-Armed, Constable (Armourer) Men and Women, and L/NKs who have put in at least 2 years of service and have passed Departmental examination as provided in the annexure. Qualifying service shall be reckoned as on the first day of January of the year in which the examination mentioned above is to be held.

		L/NK shall be deemed as Constable for this purpose. Procedure for holding of examination will be as per Annexure.
12.	If D.P.C. exists what is its composition :	DPC shall consist of three officers as decided by the DGP/IGP, Tripura. The Chairman of the DPC will be at least a Superintendent of Police or equivalent rank and other two of the rank of Superintendent of Police or Additional Superintendent of Police or equivalent rank and a representative of SC & ST Welfare Department. A lady officer should be included as a member of DPC for Women.
13.	Circumstances in which TPSC is to be consulted in making recruitment ::	As provided in Tripura Public Service Commission (Exemption from Consultation) Regulations 1973 as amended from time to time.
14.	Disqualification ::	<p>Disqualification :: No person-</p> <p>(a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or</p> <p>(b) Who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment the said post.</p> <p>Provided that the State Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing exempt a person from the operation of this rule.</p>
15.	Power to relax ::	Where the State Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do it, by order, for reasons to be recorded in the writing

		and in consultation with the TPSC, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
16.	Saving ::	Saving :: Nothing in the rules shall effect reservations relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Casts, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the State Government/ Government of India from time to time in the regard. Posts of Naiks (AB) -(Man & Woman) shall be governed by the PRB 1943 as adopted by the Government of Tripura.

1. **Short title and commencement :-**
 - (1) These rules may be called "Recruitment of Lance Naik (Armed) Men & Women, Rules, 200
 - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. **Name of the Post :**

The name of the post shall be specified in Serial No.1 of the schedule annexed hereto.
3. **Number of Posts, Classification & Scale of Pay :**

Total number of posts, classification and scale of pay thereto shall be as specified in Serial No.2 to 4 of the Schedule.
4. **Age, Educational & Other Qualifications:**

Age limit, educational and other qualification required for the direct recruitment shall be specified under Serial No.6 to 8 of the Schedule annexed hereto.
5. **Method of Recruitment, promotion :**

The method of Recruitment to the post shall be as specified under SI No.10 to 11 of the Schedule annexed hereto.

(ii) **Disqualification -**

No person --


 - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having spouse living; or
 - (b) who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts.

Provided that the State Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. Power to relax :- Where the State Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Tripura Public Service Commission, relax of the provisions of this Rule with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. Saving :- Nothing these Rules shall affect reservations, relaxation in limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Schedule Castes, the Schedule Tribes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the State Government/ Government of India from time to time in this regard. The post of Lance Naiks (Armed) Men and Women shall be governed by the FRB 1946 as adopted by the Government of Tripura.

Saving ::	Nothing in those Rules shall effect reservations of posts and others concessions admissible to SC/ST candidates and other special category candidates under relevant order of the Government of India/ Government of Tripura as may exist from time to time. Posts of Lance Naik (AB) (Man & Women) shall be governed by the PRB 1943 as adopted by the Government of Tripura.
