NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the constitution of India, the Governor is hereby pleased to make rules in the schedule hereto annexed regarding the method of direct recruitment and qualification necessary for appointment to the post of **Constable (Data Entry Operator)** of Information Technology (IT) Wing in Tripura Police.

1. Short title and commencement -

- These rules may be called 'Recruitment of Constable (Data Entry Operator) of Information Technology (IT) Wing in Tripura Police Rules, 2022'.
- (ii) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the official Gazette.

2. Name of the post -

The name of the post shall be as specified in Column No.1 of the Schedule at Annexed hereto.

3. Number of posts, classification & Scale of Pay -

The number of the said post, its classification and Scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in **Column No. 2 to 4** of the Schedule Annexed hereto.

4. Method of Recruitment, age limit and qualifications etc.-

The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, educational and other qualifications matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in **Column No. 5 to 13** of the schedule.

5. Disqualification: - No person-

- (a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
- (b) Who having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts.

Provided that the State Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personnel law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage that there are other ground for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this Rule.

6. Power to relax -

Where the State Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in the writing and in consultation with the TPSC, relax any of the provisions of these Rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. Saving -

Nothing in these Rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the SCs, STs, Ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the State Government from time to time in this regard.

PROCEDURE FOR SELECTION OF CANDIDATES FOR DIRECT RECRUITMENT AS CONSTABLE (DATA ENTRY OPERATOR) FOR THE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY WING IN TRIPURA POLICE

1. Candidates will have to undergo a speed test on standard computer keyboard (QWERTY). The minimum speed for data entry work should be 8000 computer key depressions per hour of English alphanumeric characters. The speed test will be of 30 minutes duration, and will be qualifying in nature.

2. Those candidates, who qualify in the speed test on standard computer keyboard, will have to appear for a written examination, having weightage of 85%. The syllabus and marks distribution of the Written Examination is as follows:

All questions will be of Multiple Choice Question (MCQ) type. Each question will carry 1 mark, and there will be no negative marking. The candidate will have to indicate, in the application form as to whether he/she wishes to take the Written Examination in Bengali, Hindi, English or Kokborok.

3. Those who qualify in the Written Examination will have to appear for an Interview with the Recruitment Board. The maximum marks for the Interview will be 15%.

4. The appointment will be from the merit list to be determined on the basis of the aggregate score in the Written Examination and the Interview.

5. The appointed candidates shall have to undergo basic training for **6 months**, or as prescribed by the DGP Tripura. <u>Without completion of basic training</u>, no candidate will be eligible for drawing any increment in salary.

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
