MEMORANDUM

Subject :—Revision of the scales of pay of employees of the Government of Tripura.

The undersigned is directed to send herewith a copy of this Department Notification No. F. 5(12)-FIN(G)/75 dated the 26th November, 1975, together with relevant schedule thereto relating to the revised scales of pay of the employees of the Government of Tripura for information and necessary action.

2. The Accountant General, Tripura, will check all calculations of the first pay proposed to be drawn under the revised scales of pay by the gazetted Government servants and issue pay slips.

3. As regards non-gazetted Government servants, it has been decided by the Government that the initial fixation of pay in the revised scales of pay should be checked by the Accountant General, Tripura ; but since it will take time to carry out the check and since it is the desire of the Government that the benefit of this pay revision should be extended immediately to the non-gazetted employees, it has been decided that the Heads of Departments/ Offices shall draw, on their own responsibility, the pay under the revised scales of all the non-gazetted Government servants under them, after the estimated amount necessary for the purpose is reported to the Finance Department and their concurrence obtained and then submit in batches within the six months from the date of such drawal, all the service books of the Government servants concerned and the initial pay fixation statement (in triplicate) in the form enclosed in Annexure 'A' alongwith a covering statement in the form in Annexure 'B' (in triplicate) to the A. G. Tripura, for check.

4. It has been further decided that the arrears payable for the period upto 14th August 1975, due to revision of pay scale and allowances should not be drawn now and necessary orders in this regard will be issued separately. This may be noted carefully.

5. The Heads of Departments/Offices are, however, authorised to draw the arrear pay bills from 15th August, 1975 and monthly bills of the staff on the basis of the initial pay fixation statements and also on the conditions as laid down in paragraph 3 above, but they shall take steps to make it clear to the staff that the pay fixation under the Tripura Government Servants (Revised Pay) Rules 1975 is "Provisional" and overdrawal, if any, shall be recovered forthwith. The fact of having done so shall be certified in the following forms both on the arrear pay bills and on the pay bills drawn in the revised scales of pay, till the fixation of pay is finally checked by the A., G. Tripura.

- (1) Certified that the pay fixation statements in the prescribed form have been duly completed in respect of all Government servants for whom the pay and allowances, if any, in the revised scales are drawn in this bill and will be submitted to the Accountant General, Tripura, for check by.....197
- (2) Certified that it has been made clear to the Government servants for whom revised pay and allowances, if any, have been drawn in this bill, that the pay fixation is "Provisional" and the payments are being made subject to subsequent adjustments.

6. It is likely that the pay scale of not some posts have been left out and not included in the schedule of the Tripura Government Servants (Revised Pay) Rules, 1975. Such omissions, if any, should immediately be brought to the notice of the Finance Department. The Finance Department shall thereupon take necessary action for revision of scale for them and promulgate the revised scale so revised by amendment to these rules. Till then, pay for such posts shall be drawn on the present scale of pay plus the Dearness Allowance and Interim Relief.

7. As regards quantum of Additional Dearness Allowance to be admissible on the revised pay and the rules regulating the grant of House Rent Allowance and the grant of Compensatory Allowance, Difficulty Area Allowance etc., necessary orders are being issued separately.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tripura is pleased to make the following rules namely :—

RULES

Short title and commencement

1. (1) These rules may be called the Tripura Government Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 1975.

(2) They shall be deemed to have come into force on the first day of March, 1974.

Categories of Government servants to whom the rule apply

2. (1) Save as otherwise provided by or under these rules, these rules shall apply to persons appointed to services and posts in connection with the affairs of the State of Tripura.

(2) Unless specifically extended under express orders of the State Government, nothing in these rules shall apply to Government servants of following categories namely :—

- (a) persons not in whole time employment ;
- (b) persons paid out of contingencies ;
- (c) persons paid otherwise than on monthly basis including those paid only on a piece rate basis ;
- (d) persons employed on contract except where the contract provides otherwise ;
- (e) re employed Government servants ;
- (f) officers and staff employed in the Tripura Legislative Assembly and Agartala Bench of the Gauhati High Court ;
- (g) Chairman and Members of the Tripura Public Service Commission ;
- (h) Medical Officers on deputation to this Government from Central Health Service and Medical Officers appointed by the State Government either permanently, temporarily or on ad-hoc basis ;

Explanation—In that clause the term 'Medical Officer' shall not include the State Homeopath, Medical Officer (Homeopath) and Kabiraj.

- (i) any other class or category of persons whom the Governor may by order, specifically exclude from the operation of all or any of the provisions contained in these rules.

Definitions

3. In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires—

(1) "Basic Pay" means the pay as defined in F. R. 9(21) (a) (i) ;

(2) "Existing Emoluments" includes : —

(a) the basic pay as on first day of March, 1974 of a Government servant in the existing scale ;

(b) Special Pay, if any, drawn in addition to the pay in the existing scale :

(i) in a case where a revised scale merging the special pay has been provided for in substitution of both the present scale and the special pay.

(ii) in any other case, where the special pay is, under the relevant rules, taken into account for fixation of pay on promotion or on transfer to any other post, but not including a case where special pay is attached to the revised scale ;

(c) Dearness allowance and such Interim Reliefs as were sanctioned from time to time upto 1. 3. 1974 (inclusive).

Explanation :— Dearness allowance and interim reliefs aforesaid shall be those appropriate to the basic pay and, in case where special pay is reckoned under the sub-clause (b) to the aggregate of the basic pay and the special pay as so reckoned.

Note-1 :—The rate of dearness allowance and the interim reliefs referred to in this clause are specified in Schedule-I.

Note-2 :—In the case of persons including unmarried Gazetted Officers drawing pay in the pre-1961 scales it will also include the dearness pay/allowance and cash allowance in lieu of subsidised food, if any, at the rates exhibited in Schedule-II.

(3) "Existing Scale" in relation to a Government servant means the present scale applicable to the post held by the Government servant (or as the case may be, personal scale applicable to him) as on the first day of March, 1974 whether in a substantive or officiating capacity ;

Explanation:—In the case of a Government servant, who was on the first day of March, 1974, on deputation within or out of India or on leave or on foreign service or who would have on that date officiated in one or more lower posts but for his officiating in a higher post "existing scale" includes the scale applicable to the post which he would have held but for his being on deputation within or out of India or on leave or on foreign service or, as the case may be but for his officiating in a higher post.

(4) "Present Scale" in relation to any post specified in column-2 of the Schedule-IV means the scale of pay specified against that post in Column-3 thereof ;

(5) "Revised Emoluments" means the basic pay of a Government Servant in the revised scale.

(6) "Schedule" means a Schedule annexed to these rules.

(7) "Revised Scale" in relation to any post specified in column-2 of Schedule-IV means the scale of pay specified against that post in column-4 thereof.

Scale of Pay
of Posts

4. As from the date of commencement of these rules, the scale of pay of every posts specified in column-2 of Schedule-IV shall be as specified against it in column-4 thereof.

Drawal of Pay
in the revised
scale.

5. Save as otherwise provided in these rules, a Government servant shall draw pay in the revised scale applicable to the post to which he is appointed ;

Provided that the Government servant may elect to continue to draw pay in the existing scale until the date on which he earns his next or any subsequent increment in the existing scale or until he vacates his post or ceases to draw pay in that scale.

Explanation-1 : The option to retain the existing scale under the provision to this rule shall be admissible only in respect of one existing scale.

Explanation-2 : Where a Government servant exercises the option under the provision to this rule to retain the existing scale in respect of a post held by him in an officiating capacity for the purpose of regulation of pay in that scale under Fundamental Rule 22 or Fundamental Rule 31, his substantive pay shall be the substantive pay which he would have drawn had he retained the existing scale in aspect of the permanent post on which he holds lien or would have hold a lien, had his lien not been suspended.

Exercise of
option

6. (1) The option under the proviso to rule (5) shall be exercised in writing in the form appended to the Schedule III so as to reach the authority mentioned in sub-rule (2) within sixty days from the date of publication of these rules or where the existing scale has been revised by any order made subsequent to that date, within sixty days from the date of such order :

Provided that in the case of a Government servant who is on the date of such publication or as the case may be, on the date of such order, on deputation within or out of India or on leave or on suspension or on foreign service the said option shall be exercised in writing so as to reach said authority within sixty days from the date of his return from such deputation, leave, foreign service or suspension, as the case may be.

(2) The option shall be intimated by the Government servant :

(a) If he is a non-gazetted Government servant whose pay and allowances are drawn by the Head of Office, to the Head of his office :

(b) If he is a gazetted Government servant to the Accountant General, Tripura.

(3) If the intimation regarding option is not received within the time mentioned in sub-rule (1), the Government servant shall be deemed to have elected to be governed by the revised scale of pay with effect on and from the first day of March, 1974.

(4) In case of persons who died between 1. 3. 74 and the date of publication of the rules or those who died or die on or after the publication of these rules without exercising an option within the time mentioned in sub-rule (1), they shall be deemed to have opted for the revised scales of pay from 1. 3. 74 or such later date as is most beneficial to their beneficiaries, if the revised scales are more favourable and beneficial.

(5) The option once exercised shall be final and cannot be modified or withdrawn at any subsequent date.

7. (i) The initial pay of Government servant who elects or is deemed to have elected under sub-rule (3) of rule-6, to be governed by the revised scale from the first day of March, 1974, shall unless in any case Governor by the special order other-

wise directs, be fixed separately in respect of his substantive pay in the permanent post on which he holds a lien or would have held a lien, if it had not been suspended, and in respect of his pay in the officiating post held by him, in the following manner, namely :

(a) the amount representing five percent of the basic pay subject to a minimum of Rs. 10/- and a maximum of Rs. 30/- shall be added to the existing emoluments of the Government servant ;

Explanation : If the amount so computed includes a part of a rupee, then, if such part is fifty paise or more it shall be increased to one complete rupee and if such part is less than fifty paise it shall be ignored.

b) after the existing emoluments, have been increased and computed as specified in clause (a), the pay shall be fixed in the revised scale at the stage equal to the amount so computed or if there is no such stage in the revised scale at the stage next above the amount so computed :

Provided that--

i) if the amount as computed under clause (a) is less than the minimum of the revised scale, the pay shall be fixed at the minimum of the scale ;

ii) if the amount as computed under clause (a) is more than the maximum of the revised scale, the pay shall be fixed at such maximum of that scale :

Provided further that, except in cases where the pay is fixed at the minimum of the revised scale, if the revised emoluments as determined under this sub-rule, exceed the existing emoluments by more than Rs. 75/- the initial pay shall be fixed at the highest stage in the revised scale at which the revised emoluments payable do not exceed the existing emoluments by Rs. 75/- and the difference, if any, between the existing emoluments plus Rs. 75/- and the revised emoluments so payable shall be allowed as personal pay to be absorbed in future increases in pay :

Provided further that the initial pay of a person who is first appointed to Government service after the 1st March, 1974, but upon the date of publication of these rules or when a person who was in service on the 1st March, 1974 and whose pay has been fixed in the revised scale under these rules, is appointed by transfer or promotion in another post men--

tioned in schedule IV within such period, his initial pay in the revised scale of the post shall be fixed in accordance with the Fundamental Rules : if such an appointment or transfer or promotion results in drop in emoluments in the revised scale, his initial pay shall be fixed on the date of such appointment or transfer or promotion in the revised scale of the post to which he is so appointed or transferred or promoted at a stage equal to the aggregate of his emoluments in the existing scale or if there be no such stage, to the lower stage and, the difference shall be treated as personal pay to be absorbed in future increases in pay, and for this purpose, the emoluments in the existing scale shall include :

- a) basic pay ;
- b) special pay, if merged to the revised scale ;
- c) dearness allowance and interim reliefs at the rates referred to in schedule-I :

Provided further that in a case where a special pay is attached to the present scale of pay and is not shown in Schedule IV to have been merged in the revised scale of pay, the amount of dearness allowance and interim reliefs applicable to it if any, in excess of the usual dearness allowance plus interim reliefs admissible on the basic pay only (excluding special pay) shall with effect from the date of application of the revised scale of pay, be treated as dearness allowance personal to the incumbent until he vacates the post due to transfer, promotion or otherwise.

(2) subject to the provisions of rule 5, if the pay as fixed in the officiating post under sub-rule (1) is lower than the pay fixed in the substantive post, the former shall be fixed at the stage next above the substantive pay.

(3) where the existing emoluments of a Government servant exceed the initial pay as fixed under this rule or when a Government servant, on the date he is liable to draw pay in the revised scale is in receipt of a personal pay and his existing emoluments, together with the personal pay and the dearness allowance, interim reliefs applicable to it, exceed the initial pay, as fixed under this rule, then the difference representing such excess shall be allowed to such Government servant as personal pay to be absorbed in future increases in pay.

8. The next increment of a Government servant whose pay has been fixed in the revised scale in accordance with sub-rule (1) of rule 7 shall be granted on the date he would have drawn his increment, had he continued in the existing scale :

Provided that, in the case of a Government servant who was drawing pay at the maximum of the existing scale before coming over to the revised scale, the next increment shall be granted to him on the date on which he would have drawn his increment in the existing scale had he not reached the maximum of the scale or on the date on which the increment is earned by him in the revised scale whichever is earlier :

Provided further that, in the case where the initial pay in the revised scale is fixed under proviso (i) to clause (b) of sub-rule (1) of rule 7, the next increment shall be granted on the completion of qualifying service of 12 months from the date of fixation of pay in the revised scale :

Provided also that, in the cases other than these covered by the preceding proviso, the next increment of a Government servant, whose pay is fixed on the 1st day of March, 1974 at the same stage as the one fixed for another Government servant junior to him in the same cadre and drawing pay at the lower stage than his in the existing scale, shall be granted on the same date as admissible to his junior, if the date of increment of the junior happens to be earlier.

* **Explanation** :- For the purpose of this rule increment shall be construed to mean stages in the time-scale and not necessarily actual increases in pay, (that is to say where an increment in any scale is not annual the increment shall be construed as carrying as many stages as the number of years of service required to be rendered, for earning an increment).

Note 1 - The benefit of advancing the date of next increment as mentioned in the third proviso will not be applicable in a case where a junior Government servant may have his initial pay fixed at a higher stage or draws the next increment in the revised scale earlier than his senior or seniors on the strength of his officiating service in the higher grade.

This concession will also not be admissible to a senior Government servant in respect of any period for which his increment in the revised scale is postponed due to matters unconnected with this rule namely :-

(a) withholding of increment(s) as a result of disciplinary action or failure to pass the departmental examination or prescribed training ;

(b) period which does not qualify for increment under the fundamental rules or any orders made thereunder ; and

(c) extraordinary leave not specially allowed to count for increments or in the case of a Government servant who is officiating in a post and if a certificate as prescribed in Fundamental Rule 26 has not been furnished.

Note No. 2—The subsequent increments of a Government servant whose pay is advanced as above will be regulated under normal rules.

Fixation of Pay in the revised scale subsequent to the first day of March, 1974

9. Where a Government servant continues to draw his pay in the existing scale and is brought over to the revised scale from the date later than the date of 1st March, 1974 his pay from the later date in the revised scale shall be fixed under the Fundamental Rule; and for this purpose his pay in the existing scale shall have the same meaning as of existing emoluments as defined in sub-rules (2) of rule 3 except that the basic pay to be taken into account for calculation of those emoluments shall be the basic pay on the later date aforesaid.

Fixation of pay on reappointment after the first day of March, 1974 to a post held prior to that date.

10. A Government servant who has officiated in a post prior to the first day of March, 1974 but was not holding that post on that date and who on subsequent appointment to that post draws pay in the revised scale of pay shall be allowed the benefit of the proviso to Fundamental Rule 22 or of the fourth proviso to Fundamental Rule 22-C, as the case may be, to the extent it would have been admissible had he been holding that post on the 1st day of March, 1974 and had elected the revised scale of pay from that date.

Over-riding effects of rules.

11. The provisions of the Fundamental Rules and the Tripura employees (Revision of pay and allowances) Rules, 1963 shall not save as otherwise provided in these rules, apply to cases where pay is regulated under these rules, to the extent they are in consistent with these rules.

Power to relax

12. Where the Governor is satisfied that the operation of all or any of the provisions of these rules causes undue hardship in any particular case, he may, by order, dispense with or relax the requirement of that rule to such extent and subject to such conditions as he may consider necessary for dealing with the case in a just and equitable manner.

Interpretation

13. If any question arises relating to the interpretation of any of the provisions of these rules, it shall be referred to the Government of Tripura for decision.
