**NOTE FOR COUNCIL OF MINISTERS**

**ANTYODAYA ANNA YOJANA**

A. THE SCHEME :

'ANTYODAYA ANNA YOJANA' sponsored by government of India proposes to give 25 kgs of rice per month per family at Rs.3/- per kg to the poorest among the poor. Total 45, 224 families will be covered in Tripura, being 15.33 percent of BPL households in the State numbering 2.95 lakhs as per the estimate of Government of India (40.86% of the total population households as on 1-3-2000).

B. SELECTION OF BENEFICIARIES.

The beneficiaries will be selected from both rural and urban areas. In the rural areas the stages of identification of beneficiaries are :

i. Rural Areas :

- (a) District Collectors will place into service district level officers working in the district for supervising identification.
- (b) At the Block level each Panchayat may be assigned to an officer of Revenue, Development or any other Department.
- (c) The officials at the village level will get the prescribed forms filled up by poor families and will certify the same. The officials certifying will be responsible for ensuring that incorrect information is not furnished.

- (d) A tentative list of the poorest of the poor will be drawn in each Panchayat.
- (e) The work of identification of Antyodaya family will be finalized in the meeting of the Gram Sabha in presence of Block officers. The officer should ensure that the meeting of Gram Sabha is held when there is quorum at Panchayat meeting and at such meetings the tentative list should be read out in the Gram Sabha and the names should be arranged in the order of priority.
- (f) Such approved list from Gram Sabha will be consolidated at the Block and District level.
- (g) The identified families will be given a card with a distinct colour which will have the necessary details about the Antyodaya families and scale of ration. However, to begin with, existing cards may be stamped.

ii. Urban Areas:

- (a) The preliminary identification in the urban areas, ward-wise, will be done by the Chief Executive of the Urban Local Body with the help of officers/ officials working under him.
- (b) The preliminary list of beneficiaries may be given wide publicity and also displayed at the ward-level, inviting objections.
- (c) After going through this process the consolidated list for Urban Local Body should be placed before the House of Urban Local Body and its approval obtained.


C. TARGET.

'ANTYODAYA ANNA YOJANA' target is within the revised BPL target. Thus, out of the present revised BPL target of 2.95 lakhs in the State, 'ANTYODAYA ANNA YOJANA' target would be 45,200 persons and the balance will be BPL target. The Sub-Divisional break up is marked as 'Annexure-A'.

D. COST OF 'ANTYODAYA' RICE.

The end – retail price for rice under this Yojana would be Rs.3/- per kg but it has not yet been communicated by Government of India whether transport cost etc. will be borne by Government of India fully or will have to be shared by the State Government. Food Department, Government of Tripura has made Faxed query to Government of India which is yet to be answered.
