The Government of Tripura in the SC Welfare Department is pleased to introduce a new scheme namely “**Mukhya Mantri Tapashili Jaati Bikash Yojana (MMTJBY)**” for the poor SC families of Tripura which shall be implemented during the financial year 2025-26 to 2027-28 as per framed guideline as mentioned below.

Introduction

The SC Welfare Department aims to uplift the socio-economic status of Scheduled Castes population in Tripura by providing sustainable livelihood opportunities and facilitating financial assistance where are necessary. The focus will be on self-employment, entrepreneurship and economic stability through small business, animal husbandry and allied sector. Under the scheme the following 02(two) activities namely **(A)** Poultry and Duckery rearing and **(B)** Financial assistance for Small business (Fish venders/ Dry fish venders and Vegetable venders) to poor SC families of Tripura will be implemented.

❖ Name of the Scheme :-

Mukhya Mantri Tapashili Jaati Biksh Yojana (MMTJBY) for poor SC families

❖ Objectives:-

- ✓ To encourage the weaker section of the society by promoting poultry and duck rearing and by providing financial assistance for small business.
- ✓ Provide source of regular income to the rural SC people.
- ✓ To increase income for livelihood and production and availability of poultry and duck meat in the State.

A. Poultry and Duckery rearing**❖ Duration of project Implementation.**

The scheme will be implemented in three consecutive year i.e. 2025-26, 2026-27 & 2027-28 and every year approximate 1428 beneficiary (@ 28 beneficiary per Block/ or as per ratio of SC population) will be covered in 50 RD Blocks (excluding the RD Blocks having SC population less than 10% of total population.)

- ✓ Total Unit :- 1428 Unit per year. (Approx.)
- ✓ Unit Size:- @10 birds each for poultry and Duckery of 28 days old.
- ✓ Unit Cost :- 7,000/- per unit.
- ✓ Total Project Cost per year :- Rs. 1,00,00,000/-
- ✓ Breakup of the Unit cost :-

- ❖ **Cost Norms: -** As per lowest prevailing market rate in the State determined by the purchase committee to be constituted by the concerned BDOs in which a representative from ARDD shall have to be kept.
- ❖ **Modalities for implementation of the scheme :**
 - ✓ The scheme will be implemented through Animal Resource Development Department, Govt. of Tripura.
 - ✓ The beneficiary will be selected in consultation with the PRI bodies following norms fixed by the Government. Preference may be given to weaker section like women & BPL families/ Marginal Farmers. List of beneficiaries are to be collected in the prescribed BMS format only and copy of the same must be sent to the Directorate of SC Welfare, Govt. of Tripura for record as well as audit purpose.
 - ✓ Scheme shall be implemented under the supervision of a committee to be constituted comprising of Implementing Officer to be nominated by concerned BDO, concerned beneficiary and representative from concerned GP body to be nominated by the respective Zilla Parisad.

B. Financial assistance to poor SC families for Small business (Fish venders/ Dry fish venders and Vegetable venders)

❖ **Duration of project Implementation.**

The scheme will be implemented in three consecutive year i.e. 2025-26, 2026-27 & 2027-28 and every year 500 beneficiary subject to availability of fund (@ 10 beneficiary per Block) will be covered in 50 RD Blocks where SC population more than 10% of total population.

- ✓ Total Number of Beneficiary :- 500 No. per year. (Approx.)
- ✓ Unit Cost :- Ra. 10,000/- per beneficiary
- ✓ Total Project Cost per year :- Rs. 50,00,000/-

◆ **Modalities for implementation of the scheme :**

- ✓ The scheme will be implemented by the BDOs
- ✓ The beneficiary will be selected in consultation with the PRI bodies following norms fixed by the Government. Preference may be given to weaker section of SC people. List of beneficiaries are to be collected in the prescribed BMS format only and copy of the same must be sent to the Directorate of SC Welfare, Govt. of Tripura for record as well as Audit purpose.
- ✓ Scheme shall be implemented under the supervision of a committee to be constituted comprising of Implementing Officer to be nominated by concerned BDO, concerned beneficiary and representative from concerned GP body to be nominated by the respective Zilla Parisad.

◆ **Funding: -**

- A State scheme fully funded by the State Government.

◆ **Conclusion:**

The proposed activities namely (A) Poultry and Duckery rearing and (B) financial assistance for small business of Fish / Dry fish and Vegetable to poor SC families under Mukhya Mantri Tapashili Jaati Biksh Yojana (MMTJBY) will be impactful in ensuring socio-economic development and financial security of SC communities for sustainable livelihood.

The new scheme shall come into force during the year 2025-26 and upto 2027-28 as per approval of the Government vide Note # 9 & 10 dated, 14/05/2025 of File No. 5-788/SCW/PLG/2025 (Computer No. 231809)
